

Letter to EU Importers

On November 26, 2025, the European Commission disclosed a document prior to the final provisions of the partial interim review of the anti-dumping measures applicable to imports of ceramic tableware and kitchenware originating in the P.R.C., intending to apply a definitive dumping duty of 79.0% to all Chinese enterprises, regardless of whether they submitted sampling forms during the interim review or had previously obtained separate rates (including those obtained through the EU's new exporter review), co-operating company rates, or other company-specific rates. The Commission is expected to announce the final determination on March 18, 2026. The new anti-dumping duties applicable to all Chinese enterprises will take effect the day after the final determination is announced, estimated to be March 19, 2026, based on the import declaration time by EU customs.

After the dumping duty of 79% takes effect, you, as an EU importer, might suffer great losses. As a Chinese supplier of ceramic tableware, we are deeply concerned that your company may reduce imports from China, which will impact our income. Meanwhile, EU consumers will also face higher living costs due to the shortage of Chinese ceramic tableware in the market and subsequent price

increases.

Our company strongly urges your company to submit **LETTERS OF OBJECTION** to the EU investigation authorities **BEFORE December 8th**, including but not limited to:

1. Oppose the use of Turkey as the reference country in calculating the manufacturing costs of Chinese ceramic tableware.
2. Request the EU investigation authority to pay attention to the impending massive losses that EU ceramic importers and downstream enterprises will suffer.
3. Request the EU investigation authority to consider the welfare of EU consumers and avoid imposing high anti-dumping duties on products related to daily necessities.
